Primary work through Stepping Stones new Emergency Shelter, with support for greater Shelter Program operations, Food Pantry Programs and Community Outreach. Under the guidance and support of staff, you and other Community Corps members will:

- Support shelter guests and community members in navigating health, housing, nutrition and other needs
- Assist in the recruitment and retention of crucial volunteers
- Schedule activities and partner agency services for emergency shelter clients
- Inventory, plan and procure food and other provisions
- Contribute to preparation and distribution of food through Main Food Pantry
- Coordinate shelter weekend meal prep with community partners
- Attend and support rural Pop-Up Pantries including outreach and community resource referrals
- Produce social media and other content
- Collaborate with program managers, staff, volunteers, board and committee members

Candidates must be dedicated, enjoy working alongside great people and understand the value of service to others. Candidates also need to be able to lift 30 pounds repeatedly, use a ladder and climb stairs.
